COMMUNITY GARDEN FEES, PLANTING, AND USE GUIDELINES:

- Registration for Returning 2016 Gardeners: April 2-16, 2018. Form & payment due at registration.
- Registration for New Gardeners begins April 16, 2018. Form & payment due at registration.
- Garden plots are approximately 15'x15' in size.
- The limit is 2 plots per person. Absolutely no subleasing of plots is allowed.
- **The fee is \$35 per plot for the 2018 Gardening Season (May 15 – October 1).**
- Payment of Fee: Cash or Check – No Credit Cards.
- You must supply your own gardening tools and plants.
- A water source is provided for your use. Please keep hoses wound & out of aisles when not used.
- Please be respectful of your neighbors, and keep your area neat, clean, and free of all debris.
- Trash cans are provided for all non-organic debris.
- A composting pile is provided for all organic debris.
- Garden opens at 6:45 a.m. and closes at dark each day of the 2018 Gardening Season.
- Extra produce may donated through St. John to a local food bank.
- Absolutely no rocks in aisles or tossed into neighboring plots. Carry unwanted rocks to stream.
- No illegal plants, alcoholic beverages, or smoking. Weapons of any kind are forbidden.
- No tampering or trespassing into other garden plots. You may not take your neighbor's produce.
- No ditching or damming allowed. Staking & fencing may not exceed the plot lines set by St. John.
- All stakes, fencing, and other non-organic garden debris must be removed by October 1, 2018.
- St. John Trustees will have monthly walk-throughs to monitor the use of the Community Garden.
